## A ROUND OF THE S&WMC OFF-ROAD CHAMPIONSHIP

### Supplementary Regulations

1. The Sixty and Worcestershire Motor Club Ltd. will organise a clubmans permit Production Car Trial on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2024 at Much Marcle, Herefordshire. map ref 149/649310, postcode HR8 2NS
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FISA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the Club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK permit No TBA.
4. This event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, Hereford M C, and Ross and District M C.
5. All competitors must produce a valid club membership card and (as a minimum an )RSClubmans licence.
6. This event is a round of the Sixty and Worcestershire Motor Club Off-Road Championship.
7. The programme of the meeting will be:-
  - Scrutineering starts at 9.30 a. m.
  - Drivers briefing 10:15 a.m.
  - First car starts at 10.30 a. m.
- Any competitor not signed on by 10. a. m. may be excluded
8. Public roads will not be used as link sections. There will be at least eight tests on private land. Details of the tests will be issued at signing on. The entry may be split into groups starting at different tests. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations.
9. The event will consist of two classes:-
  - A. Front wheel drive
  - B. Rear wheel drive
  - C. Specially modified Cars (as deemed by Scrutineer)All vehicles must comply with the Motorsport UK Technical Regulations and must be fitted with a horn and a silencer.
10. Awards will be presented as follows:-
  - a) 1st Overall (based on index of performance)
  - b) 1st in each class
  - c) 1st Novice (not won an award in a PCT before)
  - d) 1st Under 18

Additional awards may be added subject to entry numbers

No one can win more than one award

The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and closes on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2024. The entry fee is £22-00, unless it is your first ever PCT in which case it is £10-00 All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee

The maximum entry for the meeting including reserves is 30, the minimum is 10. The maximum for each class is 20, the minimum is 2. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Entry fees may be refunded, less £1 if notified in writing before the closing date.

13. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event.
14. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with C5.
15. Competitors will be identified by car registration numbers.
16. All other General Regulations of Motorsport UK. apply as written.
17. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the meeting in the event of unforeseen circumstances. In the event of cancellation entry fees will be refunded
18. Cars may be entered more than once by different drivers.
19. Details of tests will be issued at signing on. Starting signal will be verbal. Starting order will be at the organisers discretion
20. Practicing will not be allowed. (This includes any test driving, hand-brake turns etc. around the paddock)
21. Posts and pylons may be less than 1m in height.
22. Mud and Snow or Winter marked tyres are not permitted. (T 11.12.6) Scrutineers decision will be final. Minimum pressures will be announced on the day.
23. Entries can be accepted from junior entrants aged 14 and over who have not got a full driving licence but they must be accompanied by a passenger who holds a full RTA Licence and is a driver who is experienced as a driver on Car Trials and must produce a valid Club Membership Card. (T.4.1.3)
24. Awards will be presented after the finalisation of the results.
