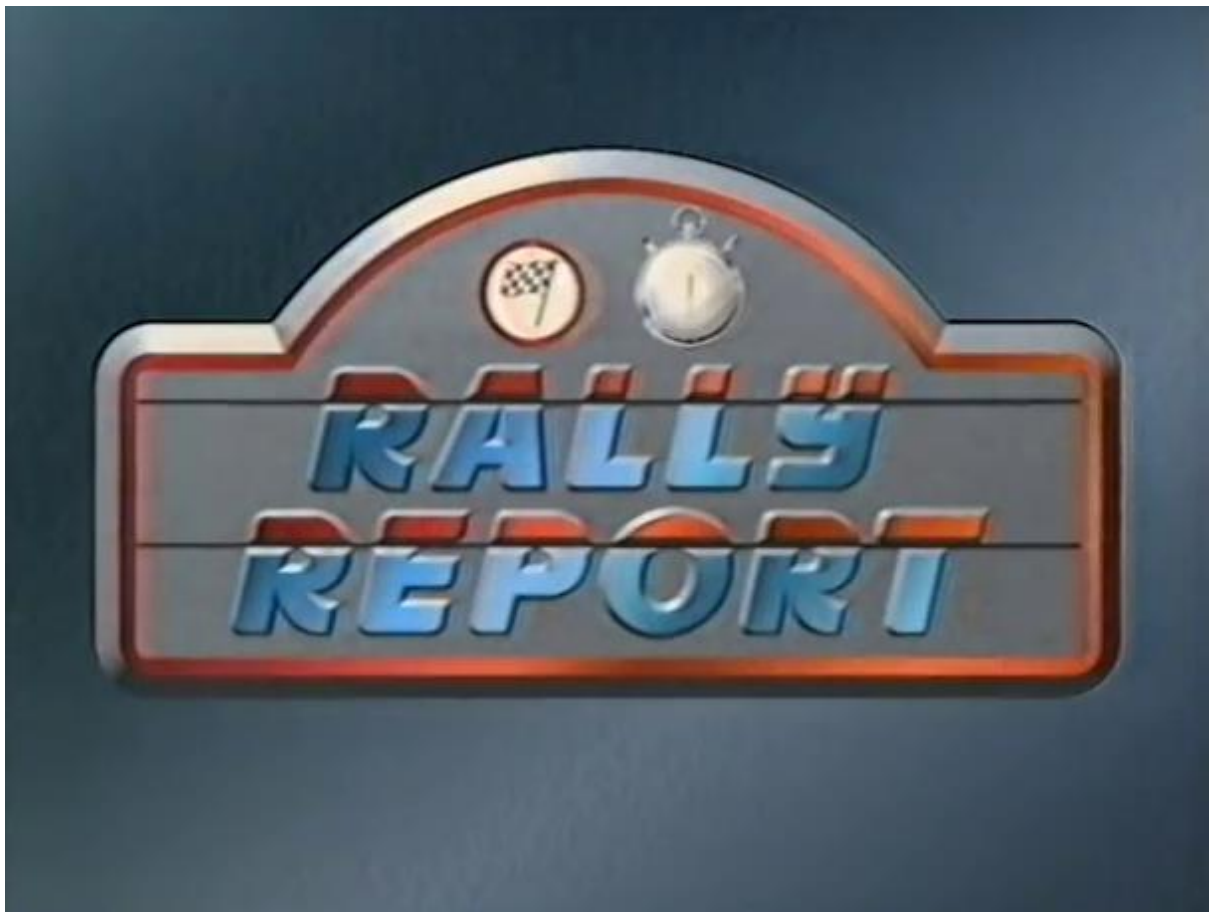
Supplementary Regulations

Welcome

As part of Sixty and Worcestershire Motor Clubs 2024 Awards night Sixty & Worcestershire Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman's Foot Rally in the afternoon before the awards. This will consist of a 2-3 mile route around Norton & St Peter's all on sealed surface, so no need to bring your wellies.

1. The event is open to everyone who purchases a ticket for the awards, these can be purchased [HERE](#) for £5 per person.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the Sporting Code of the FIA), by these Supplementary Regulations, and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for this event.
3. The event has no maximum entry, and entries will be accepted for teams of up to 4 although bonuses will be applied to those in teams of 2 or less.
4. Entries will open at 16:00hrs on the 8th and final instructions will be handed to the entrants on completion of entry.

7. The Start & Finish Venue is the Sergeant's Mess, Brockhill Lane, Norton, Worcester, United Kingdom, WR5 2PP.
8. The Route will be between 2 & 3 miles, and the correct route will be the shortest distance on any roads. There will be no need to bring any maps as the map for the event will be handed to you at signing on. You will need a Roamer and pencils although some will be available at the start there won't be enough spare for everyone.
9. The route will include grid references ,Tulips, Herringbones and other methods of route plotting, however there is no set time to have it all plotted by and there will be people on hand to aide you with the plotting as we want everyone to set off with the correct route so don't be put off by the potential for trickier navigation as the spirit of the event regarding the plotting is for those who may be more novice navigators to come away from the event having learnt more about plotting and navigating.
10. You will receive a timecard which you must get signed at all TC's. There will also be Code boards and Passage Checks along the route which you must fill in on your timecard. There will be an example of these on display at signing on.
11. The route will be timed at 3mph or 20 minutes a mile, as it cannot be expected that every team will be able to achieve this average, each team will have 5 minutes of penalty free lateness per control. Timing will be done to the next minute from arrival at a control.
12. The Penalties will be as follows

Every minute late to a control	1 minute per minute
Every Minute Early to a control	1 minute per minute
Missed Clue on route	5 minutes
Late to MC 2	5 minutes per minute
